1. Title: (To be sent in MS Word format)
2. Authorship: There is no restriction on number of authors, but we believe that a maximum of two (authors is desired. Associates should be covered by acknowledgement. The name (of Authors (should be accompanied by the name of the institution they represent, which should be marked at the end of the first page of paper.
3. Abstract: The abstract of the paper may be placed (not more than 200 words) after the title authors heading.
4. Introduction: The introduction may contain overall purpose of the paper and provide information on the Previous work of experience on the theme of the paper.
5. Main Body of the Paper: Main body of the paper should consist of the following sections:
 - a) Material and methods
 - b) Results
 - c) Discussions
 - d) Summary, Conclusion and Recommendations.
6. Length: Length of paper may be limited to 3500 words, plus necessary tables and figures. Presentation time will be 15 16 minutes.
7. Acknowledgement: Where authors desire, they may include a short section of acknowledgement. (Not to be read out)
8. Reference/Review of to be written in systematic manner that is name of Literature: authors, year of publication, title of paper/book, Publisher / page # (etc.
9. Subject Matter: Contents must be previously un printed, appropriately relevant to sugar Technology/ Agriculture, of sufficient Technical/Scientific worth and without undue commercial bias.
10. Final Copy: Complete paper should be emailed directly to the president PSST zahidmahmoodqureshi67@gmail.com and or to the General Secretary Jamil.Khanzada@omnigroup.com.pk, relevant VPs by email. ceo.srdb@gmail.com

If email is not available one typed copy plus CD (in hard cover) must be supplied by courier. Tables must be kept to minimum number, be in portrait format and the size of each table should be A4.

Submissions of Manuscripts of Papers for
54th Annual Convention of PSST,

29-30 August, 2022 at Pearl Continental Hotel, Rawalpindi

The PSST Has prepared the following Guidelines as an Aid to Authors Submitting Full-Length Convention Papers.

Please follow these guidelines strictly. Major Deviations will result in Manuscripts being rejected.

Summary:

Deadline for receipt of full-length papers	31 August. MS WORD manuscripts of full-length paper must be received by the above date. This deadline will be strictly enforced. Email your paper @ zahidmahmoodqureshi67@gmail.com
Subject Matter	Papers should be of interest to an international and national audience, of sufficient technological worth and not commercial in nature.
Length of Convention papers	Strictly no more than 3500 words Excluding title, list of authors, and abstract (no longer than 300 words). The number of tables and figures must be strictly limited and only included if absolutely necessary, information in text, tables and figures should not be duplicated.

Detailed Instructions

Format of the abstract: The abstract for full length paper should reasonably comprehensive and give the reader an adequate summary of the paper. Consequently, the abstract should be about 300 Words and must cover the following topics:

- Why the study was done (Max. two Sentence)
- How it I done (Max 04 Sentence)
- The results Obtained (Max. 06 Sentence)
- The conclusions drawn from the study (Max. 04 Sentence)
- The Abstract must not Contain any Figure or Table

Language: Papers and Abstracts Must be Presented in English

Eligibility: At least one of the authors must be a member of PSST before the paper is accepted. Authors must make every effort to present their paper at the convention. However, if they are unable to attend, they must ensure that someone with a good knowledge of the work can make the presentation on their behalf. The presenter must be able to answer detailed questions on the paper. This must be advised to the general secretary PSST at least 2 weeks before the convention.

Preparation: Before Submission, Authors must have their paper reviewed by colleagues and if appropriate by a person fluent in English. **Authors who are not fully conversant with technical English and the type of sentence construction used in technical papers of the type required by PSST must have their paper reviewed by a person fluent in English.** Furthermore, authors are encouraged to contact the relevant vice presidents of PSST before submitting their papers to clarify any doubts they may have concerning the technical content and related matter for their papers. Contact of relevant vice presidents are mentioned below.

Layout of full-length paper

The title should be as brief as possible, in capital letters not underlined and followed by author's name. using initials or preferred given names.

Detail of Authors:

The name of the authors should be accompanied by the institution they represent and its abbreviated address. In case of multiple authors from different institutions the name of each author should be marked with a subscript number beginning with 1. The address corresponding to each author should also be marked with the same subscript number. The email address of the principal author should be presented under the address. PSST discourages the listing of more than 04 authors. Authors must have made a significant contribution to the substance of the paper. Persons who only offered advice, who assisted with the experimental program and /or who directed the work of an institution should be mentioned in the acknowledgement (SEE Below)

Abstract:

An abstract of no more than 300 words must be supplied positioned below the title and author headings. It must be reasonably comprehensive and self-explanatory and give:

- Why the study was done (Max. two Sentence)
- How it I done (Max 04 Sentence)
- The results Obtained (Max. 06 Sentence)
- The conclusions drawn from the study (Max. 04 Sentence)

Keywords:

Immediately following the abstract, authors should write "Keywords". "And given no more than 5 keywords that cover the main elements of the paper.

Introduction:

the introduction should inform the reader of the overall purpose of the paper, and provide information on the previous work or experience on the theme of the paper.

Main Body of the paper:

In the case of scientific paper, it I suggested that the authors follow the standard presentation involving the following sections: materials and methods results, discussions and conclusions.

For review and description of technological processes authors should decide on the layout most suitable for their presentations. However, a section of conclusions should be included.

If the reference is to an article from a website, please use the following format:

Poland D. 1998. The Hot Button. Rough cut. Turner Network Television. accessed 28 OCT, 1998. <http://www.roughcut.com>

Reference in the text that are not in the list of references to be deleted; Similarly, references in the reference list not referred to in the text to be deleted. If several papers by the same authors in one year are cited. ABC etc. are placed after the year of publication.

Tables: Tables MUST be Kept to a minimum number and size. They must fit on to an A4 page in portrait format. Tables must be numbered consecutively, e.g., Table 1, Table 2, followed by a brief explanatory heading, referred to in the text as Such. Authors must give a due Consideration to the necessity and relevance of data tables, rather than include them simply because they are readily available on computer. Note that data should be presented in both a table and a figure. In general, it is better to present the data in graphical form than in a table. Please remember that tables should be placed at the most appropriate place in the text., not in separate files or at the end of the text. All tables must be inserted in a format that allows them to be changed by the editor (Not inserted as a "picture").

Equations: Simple Equations (i.e., one-line Equations with subscripts and Superscripts) Should be Typed directly into the text. Others should be rendered in Microsoft Equation Editor, so that errors, changes and corrections can be applied to the electronic document. If Appropriate, they should be numbered.

Figures/ Photographs: Authors must convert figures and diagrams into Microsoft Excel or Microsoft PowerPoint. Photographs Should be supplied in a JPEG format. Figures must be numbered consecutively, e.g., Figure 1, figure 2, etc. Followed by a brief explanatory title and referred to in the text as such. Color illustrations are encouraged

All Photographs, figures and diagrams should be placed in the body of the text.

Style: DO Not Underline headings or text. Please use capital letters sparingly. Do not confer capital letters on every mill station, tool, piece of equipment or apparatus etc. Whole numbers under 10 should be spelt out in the text, except when referring to

identifiable qualities, e.g., 5t/ha, and in tables. botanical and zoological genus and species names should be rendered in italics. Names of chemicals should be written out in the text, at least at their first occurrence, except when reaction equations or complex compounds are dealt with, when standard symbols should be used.

Numbers, Symbols and Abbreviations: Use metric Units for all measurements. standard Abbreviations should be used such as mm, cm, m², km, m³ etc. Please use kg/m³ instead of kg.m³ etc. Numbers greater than 9999 should be written with a comma to denote the thousand separators, e.g., 15,687.

Page Numbers: Number all pages in upper right-hand corner.

Electronic Format: Papers Must be Submitted to the General Secretary by Email. The manuscript must be provided in MS Word. Authors are requested to remove from the text file all highlights, comments, merge commands and hyperlinks. Papers must be submitted in one file, with all photographs, tables, and figures placed at an appropriate place in the text. If resulting file is very big, the file should be WINZIPPED to reduce its size.

Communication with PSST: All Communication between authors and PSST concerning full papers is with the general secretary PSST via Email Jamil.Khanzada@omnigroup.com.pk so that the processing and reviewing of papers is under effective control. The general secretary PSST Will Acknowledge receipt of all communications with authors. If authors do not receive acknowledgements of an email within two working days, they should assume that the email has failed to arrive and resubmit it.
